Pronounce "ay" in explanations as in the word "say" or "hay".

A - ah (like at the doctor)

B - bay

C - say

Ch - Che (like Guevara)

D - day

E - ay as in the word hay

F - "a" in English + fay

G - hay

H - ah-che (like Guevara)

I - e (as in bee)

J - ho-tah

K - kah

L - ay-lay

LL - ay-yeah

M - ay-may

N - ay-nay

Ñ - ay-nyay (ny like in canyon)

O - same as English

P - pay

Q - coo (as in cool)

R - ay-rray (trilled r)

RR - Dough blay ay-rray

S - ay-say

T - tay (**take**)

U - oo (like in boo)

V - bay (same as b in Spanish)

W - dough blay bay or dough-blay-oo

X - ay-keys

Y - ee-gree-ay-ga

Z - say-tah
